Position Summary:

This position will lead planning internally and externally for Boston Harbor Now, formulating the vision for the Harbor, engaging parties to implement the plan and continue to identify and further strategic priorities in Boston Harbor planning. Current strategic priorities include waterfront development, climate resilience, parks, and port operations. Specifically, the Director will be responsible for the following:

- Participate as a member of the Collaborative Leadership Team for Policy and Planning.
- Design and implement the scope of the Comprehensive Plan in the context of Boston Harbor Now's Strategic Plan in consultation and collaboration with the City and other internal and external partners.
- Design and implement planning for the Boston Harbor Islands National and State Park.
- Develop and maintain strong relationships with various relevant stakeholders including but not limited to
 - City of Boston in the City's planning process.

- Government agencies and elected officials
- o Business and civic leaders
- Waterfront focused non-profits
- Contribute to the leadership of the organization as a member of the management team and relevant board committees.
- Work closely with the Development team to recognize and pursue funding opportunities for the planning efforts.
- Advise the President and CEO on planning issues and strategic opportunities.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Proven track record of successful urban planning and implementation (preferably waterfront)including policy and advocacy
- Minimum of seven years of experience in planning and or related field such as: parks and conservation, public health, transportation, urban design and climate resilience.
